He gave details of various schemes that were being developed included the CREST scheme

This gives members of the public a direct link to reporting speeding via the CREST website on www.crestderbyshire.org/in-the-community/community-concern-sites/ using the red 'Report It' button on any of our pages if they have a speeding concern.

Additionally it was now possible for members of the public to conduct their own speeding checks using equipment and training provided by CREST.

Any vehicles found to be speeding would be written to by the Police reminding them of the speed limits in the Village.

If the situation does not improve the Police would then conduct their own speed checks.

For the local checks to take place a minimum of 4-6 villagers would be required to be trained and conduct the checks.

Additionally he gave details of Derbyshire Alert is the community messaging system for the whole of Derbyshire.

By registering, on www.derbyshirealert.co.uk/ Villagers can receive news and appeals, local crime information, and prevention advice direct to their email address.

Registration is completely free, and not only allows Villagers to receive messages about the local area, but also allows y feed back information to local policing teams to help them better look after the neighbourhood.
